WHAT IS DIFFERENT?

I. Your _____ (vs 17-18)

But thanks be to God that, though you used to be slaves to sin, you wholeheartedly obeyed the form of teaching to which you were entrusted. You have been set free from sin and have become slaves to righteousness. (vs.17-18)

MOVIE CLIP: “The Matrix” (the pill)

...You have been set free from sin and have become slaves to righteousness. (vs.18)

THE KEY: “...Recon yourselves to be dead indeed to sin, but alive to God in Christ Jesus our Lord.” Romans 6:11 (NKJV)

II. Your _____ (vs 19-20)

I speak in human terms because of the weakness of your flesh. (v.19a NKJV)

Just as you used to offer the parts of your body in slavery to impurity and to ever-increasing wickedness, so now offer them in slavery to righteousness leading to holiness. (v.19b)

III. Your _____ (vs 21-22)

What benefit did you reap at that time from the things you are now ashamed of? Those things result in death! But now that you have been set free from sin and have become slaves to God the benefit you reap leads to holiness, and the result is eternal life.” (vs.20-22)

For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord. (v.23)
