I. Courageous _____

"Jesus, Son of David, have mercy on me!"
Mark 10:47 (NIV)

Many rebuked him and told him to be quiet, but he shouted all the more, "Son of David, have mercy on me!" Mark 10:48 (NIV)

Jesus stopped and said, "Call him." So they called to the blind man, "Cheer up! On your feet! He's calling you."
Mark 10:49 (NIV)
