Ecclesiastes 3 – Perspective on Time


Appointed Times in Life


3:1 There is a time for everything, and a season for every activity under heaven:



Verses 2-8

a time to be born and a time to die, a time to plant and a time to uproot,
a time to kill and a time to heal, a time to tear down and time to build,
a time to weep and a time to laugh, a time to mourn and a time to dance,
a time to scatter stones and a time to gather them, a time to embrace and a time to refrain,
a time to search and a time to give up, a time to keep and a time to throw away,
a time to tear and a time to mend, a time to be silent and a time to speak,
a time to love and a time to hate, a time for war and a time for peace.





Living In Time ("living small") – Verses 12 &13 (NASB)

I know that there is nothing better for them than to <u>rejoice</u> and to <u>do good</u> in one's lifetime; moreover, that every man who <u>eats and drinks</u> sees <u>good in all his labor</u> – it is the gift of God.

Rejoice/Giving Thanks – Psalm 118:24; Philippians 4:4; 1 Thessalonians 5:16-18

Do good – Proverbs 3:27; Ephesians 2:10

Eat/Drink – 1 Corinthians 10:31; 1 Timothy 4:3,4

See Good in Labor – Ephesians 4:28; Ephesians 6:7&8
